ANIL KUMAR SINHA
(Supreme Court of Nepal)

Born on 31st October, 1958, Justice Anil Kumar Sinha graduated in Law from Nepal Law Campus, Kathmandu in 1982; was recognized as **Advocate** in the same year and subsequently honored by the Supreme Court as **Senior Advocate** in 2013. In his professional career of over 34 years mostly in Business Law (mainly Contracts and Commercial Arbitration, Taxation, Company Law, Foreign Investments, Banking and Insurance Law etc.), Justice **Anil Kumar Sinha** was also involved in various development projects as local Legal Counsel. He attended various trainings in Nepal, Italy and Germany too. He also worked as "National Consultant" for Public Private Partnership for Urban Environment (PPPUE, a UNDP project) and as Consultant for establishment of Early-state Hydro Power Equity Fund for a local Development Bank (USAID project), coordinated survey for harmonization of hydropower laws of Nepal, assisted to identify requisite changes in Customs Act in compliance with international conventions, worked for revision of Manual for Foreign Investment in Nepal and also reviewed the statutory provisions, procedures and court precedence related with Land Acquisition for infrastructure projects (World Bank/IMF assignments). In addition, he also coordinated a "National Survey of Public Opinion on the Judiciary in Nepal (2002)" conducted by Nepal Law Society. He is a recognized trainer on various Commercial Law and Taxation issues at the Nepal Judicial Academy.

He co-authored the country chapter of the book "**Philanthropy and Law in South Asia**" published by Asia Pacific Philanthropic Consortium, Philippines (with update in 2007) and also co-authored "**Training Manual**" and "**Legal Aid Manual**" for Nepal Bar Association. During his professional career he was affiliated to professional organizations like Nepal Bar Association, Nepal Law Society, Nepal Council of Arbitration, International Bar Association, SAARC Law, Insolvency Practitioners Association Nepal etc. He was appointed as the Justice of the Supreme Court of Nepal on 1st August, 2016 and presently he also coordinates the Information & Technology Committee at the Supreme Court.
