

HON. JUSTICE ENOCK CHACHA MWITA'S PROFILE

Hon. Justice Mwita is currently the Presiding Judge, Constitutional and Human Rights Division of the High Court. He was appointed a Judge in 2014. Prior to his current position, he served in the Environment and Land Court up to July 2015. He was to the High Court in September 2015, where he served till December 2016. In January 2017, he was transferred to the Constitutional and Human Rights Division and appointed the presiding Judge.

Judge Mwita holds a Bachelor of Laws degree (1990) from University of Nairobi and a Post-graduate Diploma in Law from Kenya School of Law (1991). He is currently pursuing MA in Environmental Law at the University of Nairobi. He was admitted to the Roll of Advocates in 1991 and worked as an advocate in the firm of **Nguli and Company Advocates** between 1992 and 1995, where was in charge of Litigation and Conveyance. In 1996, Judge Mwita established his legal practice in the name of **Chacha Mwita and Company Advocates**, where he practised until his appointment as a Judge.
